Also I was notified that the **State Champion Sugarberry** in Frederick County was cut down due to the wood decay fungus, Kretzschmaria, found in abundance in the main trunks as well as the root system making this tree very unstable.

- A Critical Area Timber Harvest Plan was submitted by Christopher Figgs of Stoltzfus Forest
 Products for a property near Lewis Shore Road in Elkton, MD. After a thorough review of the
 plan the Board voted to make a recommendation of approval provided that the harvest follows
 an approved sediment and erosion control plan, and all applicable forest harvest best
 management practices are applied to the site. John made a motion to recommend approval of
 the plan given the above criteria, Kathie seconded the motion, and no Board members opposed.
 Michael abstained from voting.
- A Forest Conservation Area Timber Harvest Plan was submitted by Christopher Figgs of Stoltzfus
 Forest Products for a property near Irishtown Road in Elkton, MD. After a thorough review of
 the plan the Board voted to make a recommendation of approval provided that the harvest
 follows an approved sediment and erosion control plan, and all applicable forest harvest best
 management practices are applied to the site. John made a motion to recommend approval of
 the plan given the above criteria, Ron seconded the motion, and no Board members opposed.
 Michael abstained from voting.
- John, Gabrielle, Dori and Emilio are meeting to make a video about Maryland Big Tree measurements at the request of DNR Forest Service leadership.
- John is working on a Maryland Big Tree specific historical timeline including photographs and information about entries to be published. John presented his current list of Big Tree notable events.
