

Slideshow Instructions

This program cycles through over 100 images of Cecil County Champion Trees. The slideshow presents an image of each tree, its measurements (circumference at 4.5 feet above ground level in inches, height in feet, and $\frac{1}{4}$ average spread of branches in feet) as entered in the MBTP, general location (GPS location for publicly accessible trees), and the year of the latest measurement. Each image is shown for approximately three seconds and then is replaced by the next image. Any image may be held for a longer time (see directions below) in order to inspect the picture or read the information at leisure. The first page of the slideshow is a menu of tree groups in order that the user may find a particular image without waiting for the entire cycle - simply choose a group for start (via mouse-click or pointer-click as determined by the hardware being used).

1. To start slideshow - click on 'slideshow' on Cecil Forestry Board website Champion Tree page.
2. Choose a tree group to initiate location in cycle of tree images (3 seconds per image).
3. To hold an image - click on 'hold' icon ('||') in top right hand corner of window
4. To expand picture - use two fingers on an active screen device; use magnifier glass icon in upper right hand corner of window when using a non-active screen device
5. To resume image cycling - click on right-pointing triangle icon in top right-hand corner of window
6. To end slideshow - click on 'X' in upper right-hand corner of window or anywhere in the outer black window area outside the tree image and information picture - will take you back to the menu page
7. To stop slideshow program and remove menu window - click on 'X' above window where the phrase 'PDF Slideshow with Fancybox 3' is located
